#### **Shortages in the Country**

Everywhere in the country people are standing in queue (line) to purchase essential items. There is a shortage of fuel, LP gas, flour, milk powder, cement, sugar and many other items.

You must book a token two days before and wait in queue from early morning to purchase some essential items. 3 or 4 people have even died while standing in queue due to sickness and fighting which occurred while waiting.

This has brought much irritation and frustration to the people and the opposition party in Sri Lanka. They are holding many protests against the ruling party in the country. Pray for Sri Lanka.

#### **High Prices of Goods**

April is known for celebrating Tamil and Sinhala New year in Sri Lanka. Hindu Tamils and Sinhalese wait to celebrate it on 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> of April every year. They start arrangements such as cleaning houses, painting and purchasing things from the beginning of April. But this time is hard to do that, the people of Sri Lanka are facing the difficult time now.

The value of the Sri Lankan rupee has dropped and prices of goods has gone high. Also the lack of goods brought the high prices of goods which benefits the traders.

Many people are starving due to this situation in the country. Believers of the churches are also affected by this.

People are moving out of the country due to this situation. Large numbers of people are going abroad looking for work due to lack of work opportunities in Sri Lanka. Some are going to neighboring countries as refuges as they feel they unable to survive in Sri Lanka.
